GENERAL PARKING

Gates: Open at 7 a.m.

All vehicles are instructed to enter the raceway via south boundary road. Ignore race traffic signs that deviate from directions below. South Boundary Entrance will be open to all in-bound and out-bound traffic. Vehicles will be parked on a first come/first served basis, with some parking areas restricted to vehicles with parking passes only.

From Highway 1:

Take the Highway 218 (Exit 403) Seaside/Del Rey Oaks exit, travel East for approximately 2 miles. Turn left on General Jim Moore Blvd Rd. Turn right on South BoundaryRd. and follow the signs to the Raceway. GOOGLE MAPS

From Highway 101:

Take the Monterey-Peninsula/Hwy 156 exit. Travel West on Hwy 156, which turns into Hwy 1. Take the Highway 218 exit East (Del Rey Oaks) and travel for approximately 2 miles. Turn left on General Jim Moore. Turn right on South Boundary Rd. and follow the signs to the raceway.





James Davison was born in Melbourne, Australia and moved to the United States 10 years ago at the age of 18. His career highlights include a runner-up finish in the 2007 Pro Mazda and 2009 Indy Lights Championships, respectively. In 2013 he made an impressive IndyCar debut for Dale Coyne Racing and in 2014 finished 16th in his debut Indianapolis 500, driving for KV Racing Technology. James returns to TRG-AMR after a full IMSA TUDOR season in 2014, scoring four consecutive GT Daytona Pole Positions in the final four races of the season. James' has come back on board with TRG-AMR in 2016 to support the team's efforts towards victory.

Derek's racing endeavors, while planted at an early age, came to fruition when Brooke asked him what he loved to do...racing was the easy and natural answer. V12 Aston Martin Vantage GT3

The Vantage GT3 has a modified version of Aston Martin's production 6.0 litre V12 engine. The dry-sumped engine produces more than 600 bhp with 700 Nm of torque and its position has been optimised further to improve weight balance. Thanks to this built-in level of performance and the performance balancing in this class, the Vantage GT3 does not require expensive yearly upgrades to maintain its competitiveness.



Lamborghini Huracán LP620-2 Super Trofeo

The Huracán LP620-2 Super Trofeo is based on the Lamborghini Huracán LP610-4. Even though it bares the same iconic silhouette as the street-legal version, this car is a precision instrument built specifically for the track. Weighing 335 pounds less and boasting 620 horse-power from its naturally aspirated 5.2L V10 engine making this car one of the fastest GT cars on the track today.



- Ignition Switch: Power is on in P1 but the engine will only run in P2. During a
 pit stop switch from P2 to P1 to stop the engine.
- 2. Start Button: Press to fire the engine
- Gear box Override (covered) In the event of a problem with eth gearbox sensor press the override switch. WARNING. When this mode is selected there is nothing to stop the user shifting into reverse!
- 4. Press to operate the fire extinguisher



Press to turn headlights on/off. Headlights will only function when the engine is running.



Press to indicate left. Press again to cancel. Indicator will automatically cancel after 10 seconds


